

How To Register

To get the complete gouge on our 50th Reunion and before you register, it is recommended that you start by reviewing all the 50th Reunion information posted on this website to see the schedule of events, event pricing, and details about each of the major events. Once you are ready to register, go to the link below which is a link to our external registration website with SignUpNow.Events which is the same vendor we used for the 47.5 West Coast Reunion.

Click on that link and it will bring you the USNA Class of 1971 50th Reunion page on SignUpNow.Events. To register you will need to create a log in with your email address and password. If you attended the 47.5 reunion, you should be able to use the same log in. Follow the directions on the website to complete registration. You will see there is an option during the registration process to break up the payment.
