

## *Coronavirus Updates and Guidance*

### **Current COVID-19 Policies for the USNA Class of 1971's 50<sup>th</sup> Reunion Events**

- Masks must be worn while travelling on our reunion shuttle buses. It is an Anne Arundel County requirement for Public Transportation.
- Registration and the Welcome Aboard Reception at the DoubleTree Hotel on Thursday - no restrictions (be advised hotel employees are required to wear masks).
- The only **indoor** event scheduled on the Yard for Friday is the Superintendent's Briefing in Alumni Hall at 1350 – 1500. Masks are required while inside Alumni Hall.
- Saturday afternoon tailgate - outdoors and few restrictions - see Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium COVID Policies below.
- Sunday afternoon events include the Memorial Service and Class Celebration 1600-1700 at the DoubleTree. Masks are recommended for the unvaccinated.
- Sunday evening Dahlgren Hall Class Dinner - 1730 to 2000. Wear Masks while entering and departing. **Also, all entering must show proof of vaccination or negative test paperwork that was completed in the previous 72 hours.**

We are currently working on various places for you to get tested (if needed for the non-vaccinated) on Thursday or Friday morning that are near the hotel. Perry Martini will send an email with details on "how to and where".

In addition, a new urgent care clinic at Baltimore-Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport offers travelers an opportunity to get a rapid or PCR COVID-19 test. First Call Medical Center is located inside the main terminal near Concourse C, behind the Jet Blue counter and outside of security, so a boarding pass isn't needed, nor is an appointment as walk-ins are welcome.
