Not having quite enough to keep themselves busy, Larry and his wife, Joan became foster parents to 180 children over a 30+ year period! Larry loved to coach kids' sports teams and was an accomplished piano player.

In his later years, he took up golf, but by his own admission, he never really had the patience for it. He enjoyed good red wine and an occasional margarita. A man's success in life can be measured in many ways. Larry devoted his life to service to God, family and country. By those metrics, he was successful in every way, with the possible exception of golf.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Joan; seven children; and 15 grandchildren. Larry was interred in Holy Cross Cemetery, St. Louis County on 22 August 2014.
