## New Smyrna Beach, FL Mini-Reunion

Dates. Tues 1 Feb - Fri 4 Feb 2022

Hotel: SpringHill Suites, 512 Flagler Ave., New Smyrna Beach, FL 32169, (386) 427-0512.

**Location**: Beachfront.

Room rates: A special Class of 1960 rate of \$125 per night has been established for the Mini-Reunion (Tues, Wed and Thurs nights). Room upgrades may be available upon check-in.

The special rate of \$125 per night is also available for Sunday and Monday evenings prior to the Mini-Reunion should you desire to arrive early. We regret the special rate is not available following the Mini-Reunion.

<u>In house food service</u>: Complimentary buffet breakfast is served in the hotel's Barefoot Bar and Cafe. Later in the day, cocktails are also available.

<u>Hotel amenities</u>: Ocean-front swimming pool, well-equipped fitness center.

<u>Travel</u>: For those that may come by air, Orlando International Airport (MCO) is served by Air Canada, American Airlines, Delta Airlines, Jet Blue, Southwest, Spirit, United, and others. MCO is 74 miles from New Smyrna Beach, about 70 minutes driving time.

Limited service is available to Daytona Beach International Airport (DAB), with American Airlines and Delta. DAB is 19 miles from New Smyrna Beach, 30 minutes driving time.

A third airport is also available, Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) with service by Allegiant, Flair Airlines, Swoop Airlines, Sun Country Airlines, and Surinam Airways. SFB is 32 miles from New Smyrna Beach, 50 minutes driving time.

## **Covid Restrictions**

Concerns for Covid infections and associated limitations continue. During our military service, we understood that personal responsibility was a cornerstone of our standards and actions. It remains so today.

Directives vary in different parts of the United States with regard to Covid.

In considering the New Smyrna Beach Mini-Reunion, Florida prohibits requirements for Covid vaccinations or tests as prerequisites for admission to restaurants, bars, public entertainment, and recreational venues.

# Specifically:

FL Executive Order 21-182 of 3 May 2021, removed all local government mandates and restrictions based on the Covid 19 state of emergency.

FL Department of Health Emergency Rule 64ER21-17 of 11 November 2021 prohibits any employer (private or government entity) from requiring proof of vaccination. Violations will result in a \$5,000 fine per individual or separate violation.

1800-1830 Vans depart SpringHill Suites for Smyrna YC. 2000-2200 Vans depart Smyrna YC for SpringHill Suites.

#### Notes for Smyrna YC dinner:

- (1) Price includes transportation between SpringHill Suites and YC (to and from).
- (2) Smyrna YC does not accept credit cards for beverages from bar. Bring cash for these items.
- (3) Dress code: long trousers (khakis or similar), open collar shirt, sport coat (ties not required).

#### Thursday 3 February

# Airport transportation, to New Smyrna Beach and return.

The B'On Time Concierge is providing transportation between the SpringHill Suites and the locations of specified Mini-Reunion activities.

They are also available to provide transportation between area airports (Orlando International/MCO, Daytona Beach International/DAB, and Orlando Sanford/SFB) and the SpringHill Suites. While transportation for Mini-Reunion activities (Kennedy Space Center, the Smyrna Yacht Club, and the Marine Discovery Center are included in the registration fees for those activities, airport transportation is arranged and paid by individual classmates.

Mr. Jeffrey Lawrence, owner of B' On Time Concierge provided the following information for us.

We have eleven drivers, some of whom are veterans or family members of veterans. My partner Vicki is a former US Army Captain, and my father was a 22-year US Air Force Segreant.

We are honored to have been chosen to assist this very elite group. In addition to providing shuttle transportation for the events, we also can provide round-trip airport transfers. We can arrange directly with you, to book in advance both arrival and departure trips for both Orlando International (MCO) and Daytona International (DAB). Currently, we only offer departure trips to Sanford International (SFB). Not arrival. We recommend any SFB arrivals use Uber/Lyft or traditional taxies.

We will be limited to the total amount of trips and time frames we can transport on February 1st and 4th, your expected arrival, and departure dates. I can assure you that once you have booked with us, we will be there for both legs of your trip. While you are in New Smyrna Beach, it can be difficult to get early morning departures to the area airports with Uber/Lyft.

We offer up to five, 6 - passenger vans, in addition to six, mid-size vehicles. If you are coming in with four to six friends and are arriving and departing at the same days and times, please let me know the lead person's name, email, and cell number. We can utilize the vans for your group.

Rates: All the rates below are based on pick-up time between 5:00 AM and 10:00 PM. We can provide pick-ups outside of those hours. There is a surcharge of \$10 per ½ hr. on those trips.

Orlando MCO: 1- 6 passengers \$160 each way, tolls are included.

Daytona DAB: 1-6 passengers \$60 each way

Sanford SFB: ONLY departing flights! 1-6 passengers \$80 to SFB

Cost per individual will vary according to the number of passengers per van.

# Mississippi River Cruise

The dates: 31 March 2023 arrival in New Orleans, 1 April embark and depart New Orleans. 5 April 2023 return to New Orleans, disembark and return home. This is a 5 day/4 night cruise, conducted by American Cruise Lines on the paddle wheeler "America."

# **Schedule of Events:**

Day prior to departure: Complimentary hotel stay in New Orleans and breakfast.

Day 1: Complimentary transfer from hotel to pier. Depart New Orleans.

Day 2: Stop at Houmas House, LA (Houmas House Plantation and Gardens).

Day 3: Stop at Baton Rouge, LA (Visit historic areas in Baton Rouge, visit the Capital building, Louisiana Arts and Science Museum, and USS Kidd (DD-661) Veterans Memorial and Museum.

Day 4: Stop at Oak Alley, LA (Visit Oak Alley Plantation).

Day 5: Debark in New Orleans around 8:00 AM. Complimentary shuttle to airport or parking garage.

<u>Travel</u>: For those who come by air, New Orleans International Airport (MSY) is served by several airlines: Air Canada, Alaska Airlines, Allegiant, American and several other carriers. Transportation from airport to hotel is on your own. For those who drive, a parking garage close to the pier is available. Daily fee is \$20 to \$25 per day.

<u>Cruise reservations</u>: The bookings for our cruise are being handled by Lulu Pincu of the Travel Solutions International USA agency, who can be reached at 972-331-4226. In addition, our classmate Don Sanders, who will be traveling on the cruise with us and providing general oversight, will also be available for general questions at (303) 589-0147.

It is important that all bookings be done through our travel agent and <u>not</u> directly with the cruise line. To maximize our opportunity for getting everyone booked on this same cruise, please try to reserve your cabin by March 1st, 2022. However, the sooner your reservation is secured by a deposit, the better. The ship only has 98 cabins; and, of course, the general public is free to book cabins at any time.

Costs: List prices for cabins are per person and are shown on page 11.

Significantly, there are a number of costs subsumed in this pricing, such as all gratuities, complementary shore excursions, and complementary beer, wine, and cocktails.

Because we are sailing as a group, we will also receive a \$600 price reduction per cabin (\$300 pp). This reduction is shown on the price sheet on page 11.

To hold a cabin, a deposit of \$500 per person is required, of which \$250 is refundable, if cancelling before the final payment date, which is 120 days (Dec. 1, 2022) prior to the sailing (Mar. 31, 2023).

To determine your specific cost, we suggest you speak with our booking agent, Lulu (972-331-4226).

<u>Insurance:</u> Insurance to cover trip cancellation is optional, but highly recommended, especially at our tender age. The extra cost varies according to your state, age, and cruise cost, but an average for an 85 year old purchasing the highest cost cabin is \$ 374 pp. If this insurance is purchased within 14 days of the deposit date, any pre-existing medical conditions are covered. The cost of the trip is covered, but the plan also covers medical emergencies, baggage delay, emergency evacuation and other things. The TSI USA travel agent can help you purchase the plan that is best for you.

<u>Just remember</u> when reading the web info and it says, "contact a travel specialist," <u>do not</u> call their number, but use our travel agent's (Lulu) number at 972-331-4226.

# **Comments:**

- (1) "America" has a capacity of 185 guests. It is highly desirable that Class of '60 members/guests procure reservations as early as possible. Waiting until later risks space being taken by early "walk-ons" (individuals not our Class or guest). It is recommended that Classmates and guests register soon if they desire to take the Mississippi River cruise.
- (2) See notes above describing "Insurance" (cancellation of travel) and refund of reservation deposits.
