Information Sheet for 45th Reunion



1. Getting around

- a. Security & Parking
 - 1. While you can drive onto the yard with a DOD ID card, parking is <u>extremely limited</u> due to extensive new construction: Cyber Building, Parking Garage, Rickover Hall renovation, and Santee Basin seawall replacement. You cannot drive between Alumni Hall/Nimitz Hall and college creek. Road is closed.
 - 2. Construction equipment and Midshipman parking take up what little remains. <u>Bottom line</u>: recommend not driving onto the yard Thursday/Friday. Saturday (mid store run) may be a bit easier and Sunday might be okay, but keep in mind this is a Homecoming weekend for all classes.
 - 3. <u>Suggestion</u>: If you must drive, use the city parking lot (accessible from Duke of Gloucester Street or Main Street) or park at the harbor area, and walk into Gate One via the adjacent walking entrance (At the corner of Halsey Field House- around the corner from the drive-in entrance) called Perry Gate, and go through security (only requires driver's license).
