Survey Results

- Survey conducted 31MAR21 23APR21
- Survey vendor SimpsonScarborough provided initial survey data to BOT in late June. The initial analysis required additional effort that SS determined was beyond their capability to support.
- Contract established in Aug with Fleishmann Hillard to continue analysis and provide report
- FH draft report submitted to AdHoc committee in late Nov



High Level Early Observations

- Confusion over AA, Foundation and A&SP mission and intersection
- Opportunities exist to increase engagement with younger alumni
- Continued demand signal for Alumni Service Support: (Career Services, Alumni Mentoring, Business Networking)



Next Steps

- Initial Survey findings and Draft report from FH being reviewed by BOT & AdHoc Cmte
- Anticipate follow on mtgs with BOT, BOD, COCP and other volunteer leaders in January prior to release of final report to all alumni
