Ed O'Callaghan joined Northrop Grumman in 2019, and serves as Corporate Director, USG International Programs and Policy in the Corporate Global Business Office. Previously, he was a career naval officer with 30 years of service. Designated as a Naval Flight Officer, he spent his operational time in P-3 Squadrons, and commanded the 562nd Flying Training Squadron, a joint USN-USAF T-43 squadron. Ashore he served multiple tours in the Pentagon (OPNAV Staff; as a Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of the Navy; and on the Joint Staff as a speech writer for the Chairman). He also spent two tours overseas on maritime patrol staffs in Keflavik, Iceland and Naples, Italy. He retired from the Navy in 2010 as a Captain.
