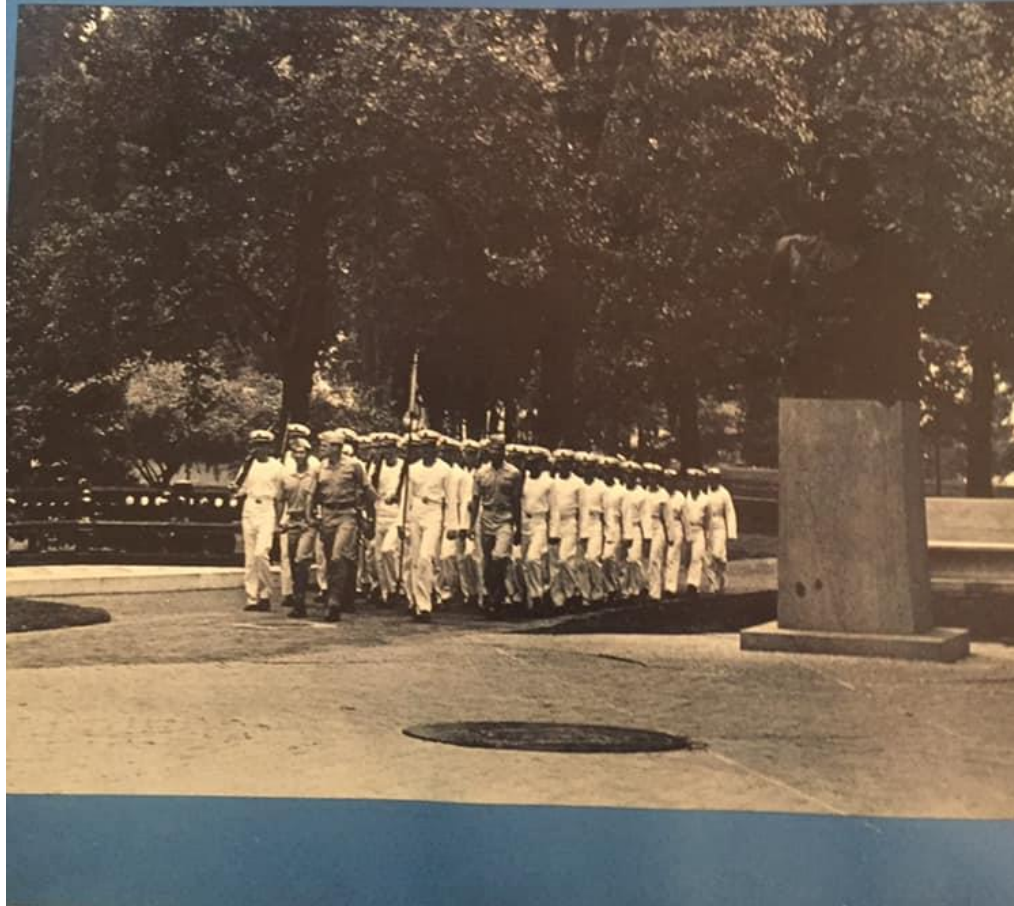

PLEBE LIBERTY AND PRIVILEGES INFORMATION FOR PARENTS' OPEN HOUSE WEEKEND

1. Liberty for Fourth Class

a. Definitions:

(1) Town Liberty - When Town Liberty is granted during Parents' Open House Weekend, midshipmen are authorized to visit that area within a circle whose radius is twenty-five miles from the Chapel dome. Midshipmen must wear the Uniform of the Day during Town Liberty.

(2) Yard Liberty - When Yard Liberty is granted, midshipmen are authorized to visit specified areas or places within the yard, plus Perry Circle, the quarters on County Road near Perry Center and Arundel Estates officers' quarters. Midshipmen may sail during Yard Liberty.

(3) Recreational Liberty - Recreational Liberty is granted for the purpose of voluntary participation in athletics. It will be granted concurrently with Town or Yard Liberty. Midshipmen may take Recreational Liberty in the following areas: 7th and 8th Wing tennis courts, Bancroft Hall bowling lanes, Thompson, Farragut, Dewey, Lawrence, and Hospital Point Fields, authorized sailing areas, golf course, Field House and Macdonough Hall. Midshipmen proceeding to and from the golf course, sailing center, or bowling lanes will wear white works over gym gear.

(4) Personal Time - This time is granted to midshipmen so that they can take care of military and personal needs. They may not escort or take liberty during Personal Time.

(5) Taps - At Taps all midshipmen will be in their bunks in their company areas. An accountability inspection will be taken at that time.

(6) Meal Formations - When meal formations are scheduled, a midshipman must be in his/her squad ranks at the "Formation Late Bell."

b. Liberty schedule for the Class of 1980 during Parents' Open House Weekend is as follows:

(1) Friday, 27 August 1976

1200: Noon Meal Formation.
1210: Town Liberty Commences.
1730: No Evening Meal Formation. (Families of Starboard Battalion midshipmen are invited to dine in the Midshipmen Wardroom.)
2400: Town Liberty expires. Taps.

(2) Saturday, 28 August 1976

0730: Morning Meal Formation/Mandatory Meal.
0830 - 1030: Parents and guests tour Bancroft Hall and visit midshipmen rooms.
1030 - 1130: Personal Time (prepare for Noon Meal Formation).
1130: Noon Meal Formation.
1140: Town Liberty Commences.
1730: No Evening Meal Formation. (Families of Port Battalion midshipmen are invited to dine in the Midshipmen Wardroom.)
1830: Town Liberty expires. Yard Liberty commences.
2400: Yard Liberty expires. Taps.

(3) Sunday, 29 August 1976

0830: Yard Liberty commences.
1230: Yard Liberty expires. Noon Meal Formation.
1230 - 1400: Personal Time.
1445 (about): Town Liberty commences after Dress Parade.
1900: Town Liberty expires. Evening Meal Formation.
Ends Parents' Open House Weekend for Class of 1980.

2. Privileges for Fourth Class

a. Alcoholic Beverages - Midshipmen of the Class of 1980 shall not consume or have in their possession any alcoholic beverages unless specifically authorized by the Commandant of Midshipmen.

b. Automobiles - Midshipmen Fourth Class are authorized to ride in automobiles only when driven by their parents, parents of classmates, USNA civilian faculty members, or officers of the Naval Academy and Naval Station, commencing after Noon Meal Formation 27 August, and expiring 1900, 29 August 1976.

c. Escorting - Midshipmen Fourth Class are authorized to escort their parents and guests for Parents' Open House Weekend during periods of Yard and Town Liberty.

d. Uniforms - Midshipmen will wear Tropical White Long uniforms while on Yard or Town Liberty, with exception of Sunday Chapel when Service Dress White will be worn or when midshipmen are engaged in Recreational Liberty as described in paragraph 1a(3). Midshipmen Fourth Class may not wear civilian clothing at any time.

e. Use of Recreation Centers - Midshipmen Fourth Class are authorized to use the Steerage in Bancroft Hall and Drydock/Recreation Facilities in Dahlgren Hall during their Yard and Town Liberty periods. Consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Drydock by Midshipmen Fourth Class is prohibited.

f. Officers'/Faculty Club Usage - Use of Officers'/Faculty Club dining facilities by Fourth Class Midshipmen when they are escorted by their parents or guardians is authorized. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by Fourth Class Midshipmen in the Officers' and Faculty Club is prohibited.

Parents Weekend 4th Class Liberty
