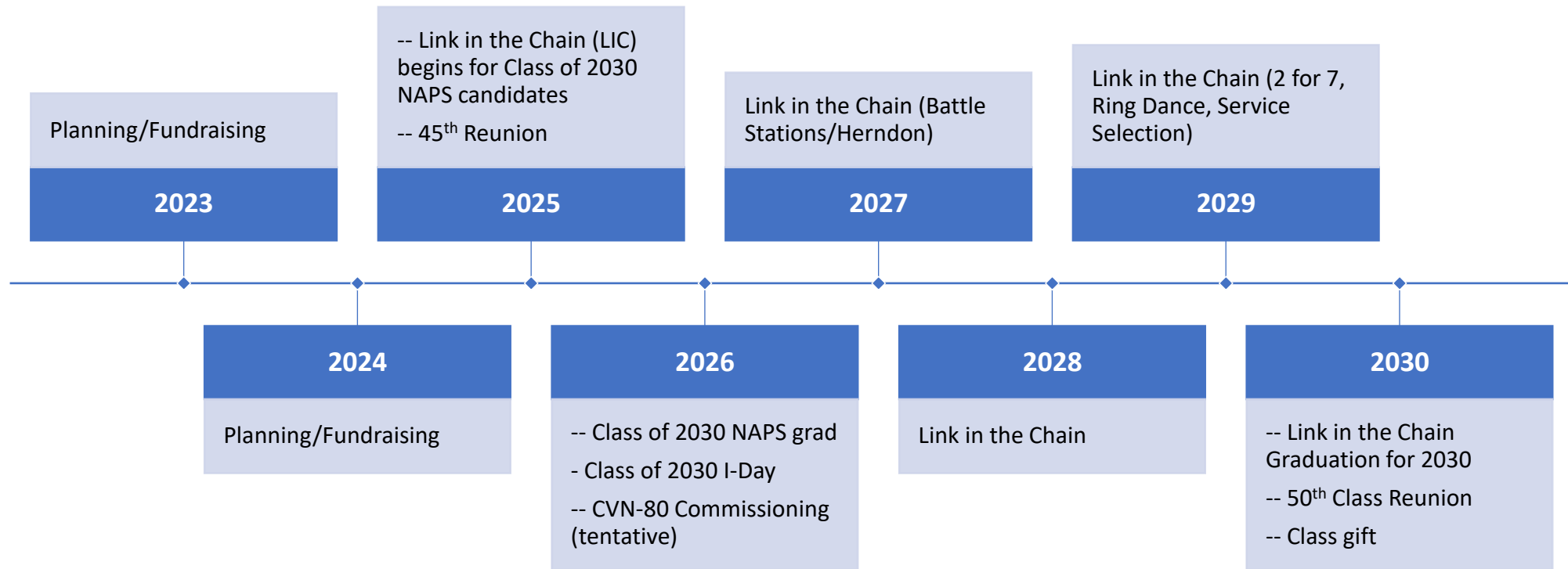

Some directly in front of us (Reunion and Link in the Chain)

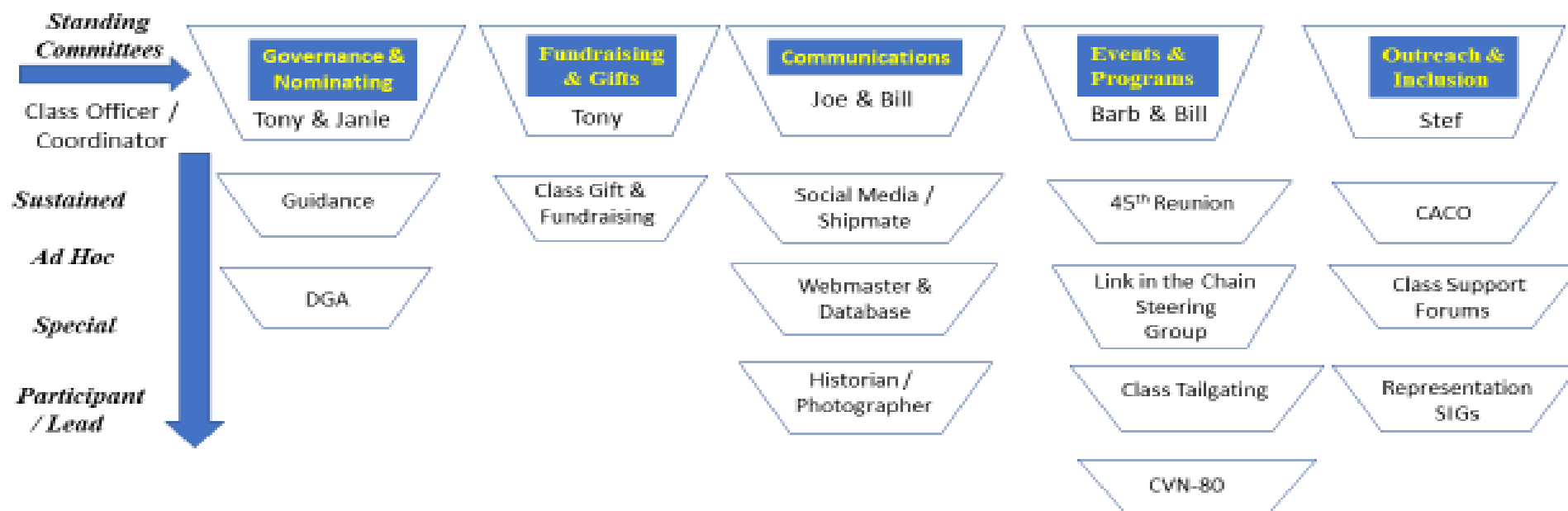

Note 1: Coordinators oversee the work of the Committees / Representation in their "pillar".

Note 2: Sustained Committees have an ongoing requirement to support the Class.

Note 3: Ad Hoc and Special Committees or Projects have a defined timeframe to support the Class.

Note 4: The Standing Committee Coordinators are typically Class Officers who advocate for the efforts within their "pillar" and receive periodic reports on the progress of the work from the assigned Leads.

Note 5: The assigned Leads for the efforts within a "pillar" will plan the work, request resources when applicable, and provide periodic reports to the Coordinator.

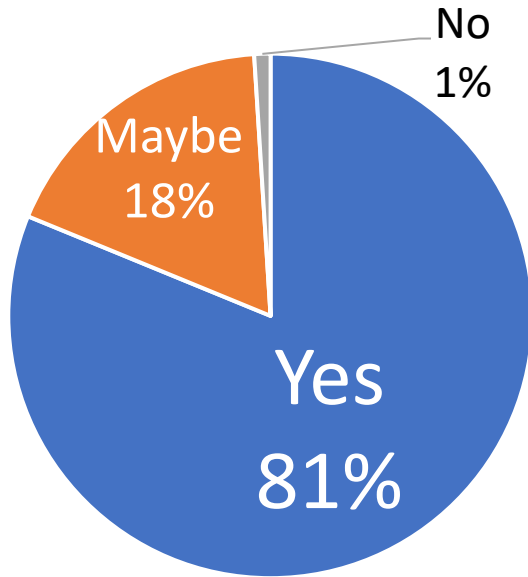

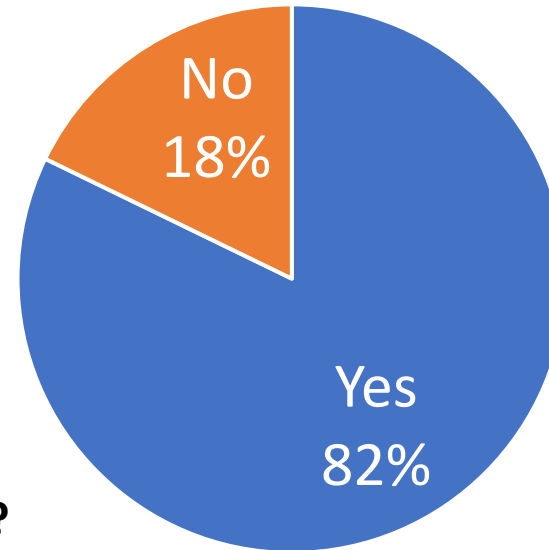

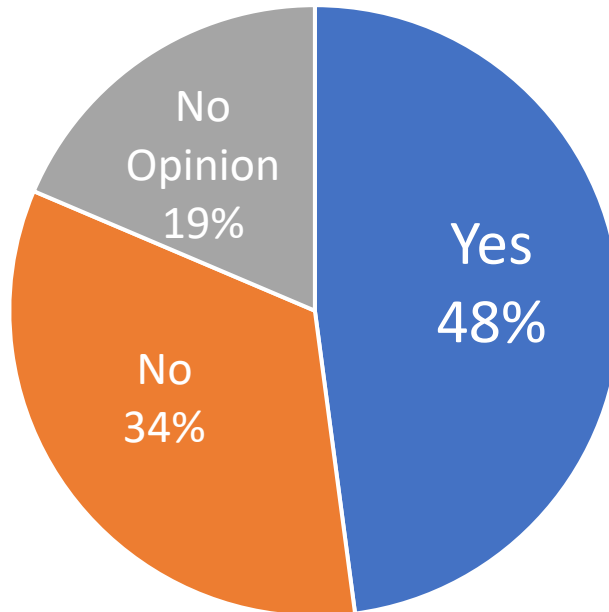

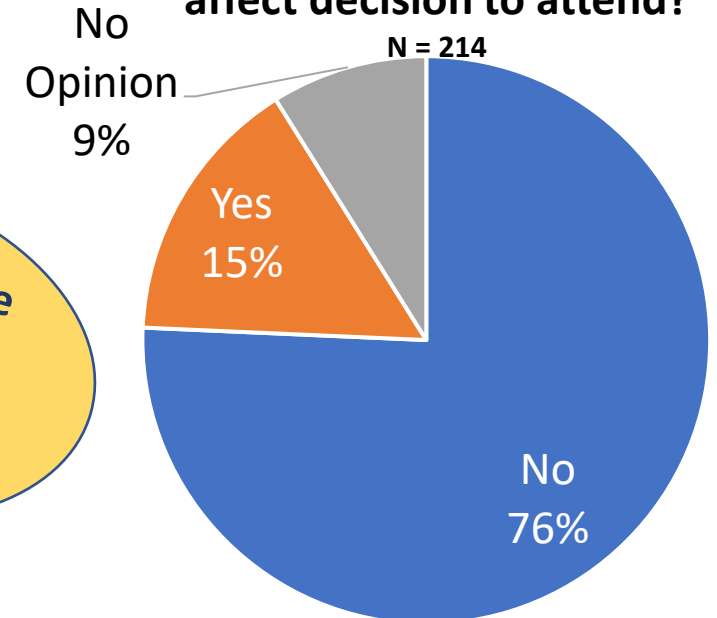

Venue

USNA

- Chapel, Yard, Annapolis
- Better opportunity to partner with Navy sporting event
- Competing with Annapolis events
- Travel convenience

Other US Location

- Shares travel burden
- Not in/adjacent to the Yard
- Less opportunity for Navy sporting event
- Reduced competition for Annapolis resources

Time of Year

Spring

- Focus on Lacrosse or Baseball event
- More options for lodging/transportation
- Less competition for venues

Fall

- Better chance for home football game
- Competing with other Classes for reunion resources
- Boat Show and other fall events in Annapolis

Factors affecting Reunion Planning



- Navy Football Schedule posts in late February of upcoming season
 - Selecting reunion weekend date must happen at least 2 years prior to event
- Air Force, Notre Dame and Army scheduled years in advance
- Typical reunion year 10-12 Classes competing for each home football weekend
- Boat shows on two consecutive weekends
- Limited hotel and rental units on busy weekends
- Parking and transportation in Annapolis
 - Includes shuttles to/from hotels and in Yard
