The picture from a 1976 Navy recruiting booklet shows Tim Kobosko, Don Harker, Ed Martin, Pat Inglis, Doug Leivonen, Don Jones, Greg Hightain--among over twenty more future classmates--in civies and 70s high school hair. I'm way in the back, left along the curb, three from the end and out of step as usual. Former USN/USMC enlisted arrived at various times over the end of July and early weeks in August, with Janice Bauxbaum, Lynn Vosbury, and Amber Hernandez joining us in January.

It was 50 years ago . . . .

Tony Mosley and I, as I've mentioned before both Platoon 1-2 Napsters and First Company, wanted to get together the first weekend in August, in Newport, to mark the 50th anniversary of NAPS I-Day August 8. This year has the same calendar sequence at 1975 so the timing was perfect. Once we started tossing the idea out to our Naps buddies, the immediate and enthusiastic response convinced us to take a step back and try to get as many of the almost 200 Naps '80 classmates to join us with a better and more convenient date. Naps '76/USNA 80 had a 35<sup>th</sup> Reunion in October 2011 with 62 classmates attending. We hope to do as well or more.
